The international Internet Governance regime

- There is an international Internet Governance regime which emerged in the last four decades. This regime is not based on an inter-governmental agreement but on consensual and collaborative practices and institutions.
- Working definition of Internet governance: "is the development and application by Governments, the private sector and civil society, in their respective roles, of shared principles, norms, rules, decision-making procedures, and programmes that shape the evolution and use of the Internet" (WGIG, 2005).

The role of governments

Governments were newcomers to the field of Internet governance. While in other negotiations, inter-governmental regimes gradually opened to nongovernmental players, in Internet governance negotiations, governments had to enter an already existing non-governmental regime, built around IETF, ISOC, and ICANN. Once Internet governance became a global issue, there was a need to converge these two regimes (non-governmental and traditional diplomatic regimes) through the development of a multistakeholder policy framework. (Kurbalija, 2012: 172)

Reasons for the interest in governments in shaping and participating the international agenda in Internet Governance regime

- Strike a balance in a multi-polar world of powers
- Cultural and lingüistic
- Country names, brands, geographical denominations and designations of origin
- Involve national capacity in ICT and Internet development
- Economic and social benefits
- Other
